all you who are upright in heart.

Psalm 32:10-11 (NASB)

I will rejoice and be glad in your
lovingkindness, because you have
seen my affliction;
You have known the troubles of my soul.

Psalm 31:7 (NASB)

But let all who take refuge in You be glad,
Let them ever sing for joy;
and may You shelter them, that those
who love Your name may exult in You.

Psalm 5:11 (NASB)

Now to Him who is able to keep you
from stumbling, and to make you stand
in the presence of His glory
blameless with great joy.

Jude 1:24 (NASB)

Is anyone among you suffering?
Then he must pray. Is anyone cheerful?
He is to sing praises.

James 5:13 (NASB)

Consider it all joy, my brethren, when you encounter various trials, knowing that the testing of your faith produces endurance. And let endurance have its perfect result, so that you may be perfect and complete, lacking in nothing.

James 1:2-4 (NASB)

Rejoice in the Lord always;
Again I will say, rejoice!

Philippians 4:4 (NASB)

But in everything commending ourselves as servants of God...
As sorrowful yet always rejoicing,
as poor yet making many rich,
as having nothing yet possessing all things.

II Corinthians 6:4a, 10 (NASB)

I will rejoice greatly in the Lord,
My soul will exult in my God;
for He has clothed me with garments of salvation,
He has wrapped me with a robe of righteousness,
as a bridegroom decks himself with a garland,
and as a bride adorns herself with her jewels.

Isaiah 61:10 (NASB)

Proverbs 17:22 (NASB)

Matthew 25:23 (NASB)

I will be glad and exult in You;
I will sing praise to Your name,
O Most High.

Psalms 9:2 (NASB)

But I have trusted in Your lovingkindness;
My heart shall rejoice in Your salvation.
I will sing to the Lord,
because He has dealt bountifully with me.

Psalm 13:5-6 (NASB)

Let all who seek You rejoice
and be glad in You;
Let those who love Your salvation say
continually "The Lord be magnified!"

Psalm 40:16 (NASB)

Restore to me the joy of Your salvation
and grant me a willing spirit
to sustain me.

Psalm 51:12 (NIV)

For Your lovingkindness is great
in the heavens
and Your truth to the clouds.
Be exalted above the heavens, O God;
Let Your glory be above all the earth.

Psalm 57:10-11 (NASB)

Enter His gates with thanksgiving and His
courts with praise. Give thanks to Him and
bless His name. For the Lord is good;
His lovingkindness is everlasting and
His faithfulness to all generations.

Psalm 100:4-6 (NASB)

Sing praise to the Lord, you His godly ones,
and give thanks to His holy name.
For His anger is but for a moment,
His favor is for a lifetime;
Weeping may last for the night,
but a shout of joy comes in the morning.

Psalm 30:4-5 (NASB)

He put a new song in my mouth, a song of
praise to our God; Many will see and fear
and will trust in the Lord.

How blessed is the man who has made
the Lord his trust, and has not turned to the
proud, nor to those who lapse into falsehood.

Psalm 40:3-4 (NASB)

Deliver me from bloodguiltiness, O God,
the God of my salvation;
Then my tongue will joyfully sing
of Your righteousness.
O Lord, Open my lips,
that my mouth may declare Your praise.

Psalm 51:14-15 (NASB)

Shout joyfully to the Lord, all the earth;
Serve the Lord with gladness;
Come before Him with singing.
Know that the Lord Himself is God;
it is He Who has made us and not we
ourselves; we are His people and
the sheep of His pasture.

Psalm 100:1-3 (NASB)
