Ephesians 3:17b-19 (NASB)

For God so loved the world,
that He gave His only begotten Son,

shall not perish but have Everlasting life.

John 3:16 (NASB)

Be devoted to one another in brotherly love;
Give preference to one another in honor;

Romans 12:10 (NASB)

All the paths of the Lord are
lovingkindness and truth
to those who keep His covenant

Psalms 25:10 (NASB)

In the same way the Holy Spirit also helps our
weakness; for we do not know how to pray as
