Psalm 37:7 (NASB)

God is our refuge and our strength,  
a very present help in trouble.

Psalm 46:1-2 (NASB)

He makes me lie down in green pastures;  
He leads me beside quiet waters.  
He restores my soul; He guides me in the  
paths of righteousness for His name's sake.

Psalm 23:2-3 (NASB)

Trust in the Lord and do good;  
Dwell in the land and  
cultivate faithfulness.

Psalm 37:3 (NASB)

The angel of the Lord encamps around

Psalm 34:4 (NASB)

In you, O Lord, I have taken refuge; let me never be ashamed; in Your righteousness deliver me. Incline Your ear to me, rescue me quickly; be to me a rock of strength, a stronghold to save me. For You are my rock and my fortress; for Your name's sake, You will lead me and guide me.

Psalm 116:7-8 (NASB)

Psalm 18:2 (NASB)

Psalm 46:7 (NASB)

Cease striving and know that I am God;  
I will be exalted among the nations,  
I will be exalted in the earth.

Psalm 46:10 (NASB)

I will cry to God Most High,
